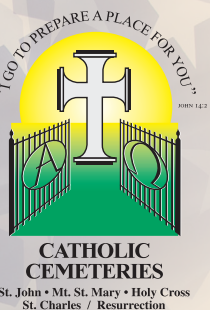
Mission Statement
